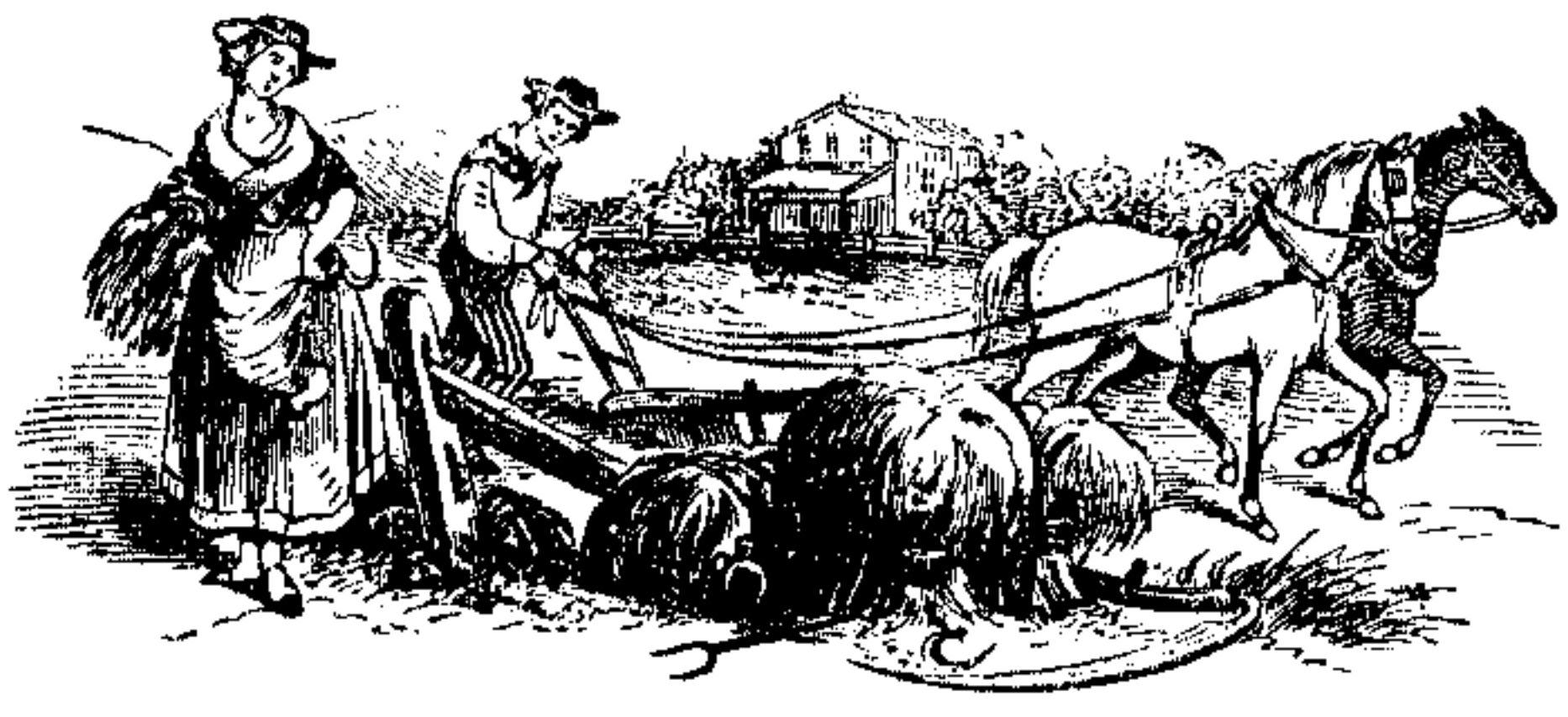

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

Homestead Certificate No. 561

Application 1121

Whereas, there has been deposited in the **General Land Office** of the United States, a **CERTIFICATE** of the Register of the Land Office at *Falls St. Croix*,

Wisconsin, whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of *Angeline M. DeLong*, formerly widow of *John Hoyt* deceased, has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the West half of the North West quarter of Section *twelve*, in Township *twenty-six*, of Range *fourteen* in the district of lands subject to sale at *Falls St. Croix, Wisconsin*, containing *eighty acres*.

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the **General Land Office** by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**.

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the **UNITED STATES** unto the said *Angeline M. DeLong*, the tract of Land above described: **To Have and to Hold** the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Angeline M. DeLong*, and to her heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof, *S. Myrales D. Grant*, PRESIDENT OF THE **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the **Seal of the General Land Office** to be hereunto affixed.
