REPORT OF PROCEEDINGS

From 8 a. m. to 9:30 a. m. comrades of the two regiments registered, paid annual dues (50 cents), and were decorated by G. A. R. ladies in attendance. At 10:30 a. m. President Kellogg called attention. Invocation by Chaplain Clark, all standing. Eloquent address of welcome by Mayor of the city, Hon. George R. Lunn. Response by Comrade Wm. S. Hall. Patriotic address by Hon. Frank Crowther, our member of congress, which was received with tumultuous applause. He was followed by our assemblyman, Hon. William W. Cambell, a veteran of the World War. We were also favored by an address from Department Commander, State of New York, Isadore Isaacs, and T. J. Conkey, Adjutant, Department of New York, and Major J. S. Clinton, Commandant of the Armory, in which the re-union was held, and who did all he could to insure our pleasure and comfort. Major Clinton is a World War veteran and was in command of the 2nd Battalion of the gallant 105th Regiment, New York Infantry.

At 12:30 p. m. the oratory having come to an end, adjournment was voted for an excellent dinner, provided and served in a delightful manner in the mess room of the armory by the Sons of Civil War Veterans Auxiliary and their ladies to the comrades of the 115th and the 153rd regiments and their families. The response was so hearty and cordial that about two hundred and fifty partook heartily of the spread and elected that it was the best ever.

At 2:30 p. m. President Kellogg again swung the gavel and the business session was on. Reading of minutes of last re-union. That section forty-seven hundred and forty-five, title fifty-seven of the Revised Statutes of the United States is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 4745.—Any pledge, mortgage, sale, assignment, or transfer of any right, claim, or interest in any pension which has been, or may hereafter be, granted, shall be void and of no effect, and any person who shall pledge, or receive as a pledge, mortgage, sale, assignment or transfer of any right, claim, or interest in any pension, or pension certificate, which has been, or may hereafter be granted or issued, or who shall hold the same as collateral security for any debt, or promise, or upon any pretext of such security, or promise, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in a sum not exceeding one hundred dollars and the costs of the prosecution; and any person who shall retain the certificate of a pensioner and refuse to surrender the same upon the demand of the Commissioner of Pensions, or a United States pension agent, or any other person, authorized by the Commissioner of Pensions, or the pensioner, to receive the same shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in a sum not exceeding one hundred dollars and the costs of the prosecution.
